- A. The recipient must be a NJWRC member.
- B. The recipient must been involved in the raising, showing or breeding of rabbits for the previous 2 consecutive years prior as well as the year applying for the scholarship.
- C. The Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, attending college/ trade school.
- D. The scholarship will be paid to the recipient upon submitting proof of enrollment in an accredited two or four year college/university, vocational or technical school, or by submitting education-related expenses.
- E. Completed application forms must be submitted no later than October 30th.
- F. Each applicant is only eligible to receive a scholarship once.
- G. Application must be accompanied by an official High School transcript.

GUIDELINES FOR THE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

1. This Fund shall be governed solely by the Brian Hartzell Youth Scholarship Fund committee.
2. The committee shall consist of three members; two of the three members of the selection committee will be members of NJWRC, the third shall be a member appointed to represent the Family of Brian Hartzell
3. The recipients of the NJWRC youth scholarship shall be selected prior to the ARBA Convention. The scholarship will be awarded at the NJWRC Awards banquet. Recipient need not be present to receive award.
4. The amount awarded for each youth scholarship will be determined based on the financial status of the Brian Hartzell Youth Scholarship Fund. There will be a minimum of one (1) scholarship awarded each year of \$500.
5. The Brain Hartzell Youth Scholarship Fund committee shall be responsible for application forms, criteria, and selection of scholarship winners.
